Activities Summary: Students extend their skill in performing conversions to using proportions and unit rate. In Grades 4 and 5, students use tables and informal proportional reasoning to perform conversions. Grade 6 introduces two more strategies for performing conversions: proportions and unit rate. The following activities are also in the Grade 6 **Geometry and Measurement** cluster.
